The Effects of the Financial Crisis are being felt...

The financial crisis in the second half of 2008 has left the world in economic turmoil, and has not spared the electrolytic manganese metal and manganese dioxide markets. Although the Chinese government has announced many favorable policies to stimulate the domestic markets, the outlook for the economy in foreseeable future remains uncertain.

What does 2009 hold in store for the Markets?
